
- Strategic versus opportunistic

 - Strive for a balance weighted towards strategic




Strategic Project Selection




- River Stewards Program <u>link to program page</u>

 - Focus on diversity of habitat






Current Strategic Project Work

 - Great projects happen in both categories







Opportunistic Work
